Build a collaborative network of teacher-researchers regionally and statewide	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Establish teacher inquiry groups at the three Writing Project sites statewide; • TICLN team will meet, collaborate and plan on a regular basis throughout the year
Enhance teacher expertise through the process of teacher inquiry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Guide participating teachers through the inquiry process; • Encourage professional reading and research
Sustain teacher inquiry communities with support from Writing Project sites	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fiscal support for programs from Writing Project sites and grants (anthologies, books, incentives, credits, travel, etc.) • Implementation of local inquiry groups • Frequent state-level planning by TICLN team • Meetings of inquiry participants statewide using technology
Establish and maintain meaningful professional development experiences and build leadership capacity for teachers at the classroom, school site and state levels through teacher inquiry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facilitate development of meaningful research questions for participants • Support teachers through data collection, analysis and reflection • Encourage extension of the work of teacher inquiry groups through professional publication, development of workshops/in-service, conference presentations, etc. • Sharing of groups' inquiry projects with school administrators, legislators, parents, and Writing Project sites
